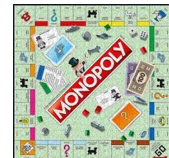

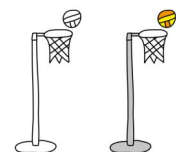
Trials will take place at school to select our team to represent the school at County Cup and League matches. We play a mixed team so both boys and girls will be welcome.
