Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are writing to update you with some details and dates for diaries for what we hope will be an exciting final half-term for Year 6.

On **Wednesday 15th July**, Year 6 are due to perform their end of year production. This year, we are extremely excited to announce the performances will be at the **Waypoint Church** on Hunts Pond Road. This will be a fantastic opportunity for the Year 6 children, who will be performing alongside appointed professional technicians and will gain experience of performing on a larger stage. Furthermore, we can offer a much larger seating capacity for the audience.

Production

The Year 6 team are busy planning and preparing for our Year 6 production, 'Wonderland The Musical'. Auditions will take place and we will start rehearsing, creating sets and costumes for what we hope will be a fantastic show.

There are two performances planned as shown below; we are not quite sure how long a performance will last so timings given are approximate. We will write nearer the time with more details, including dropping off and picking up times for the performances at the Waypoint church.

Tickets

This year, we will be offering 2 performances: **one matinee and one evening show**. Available to purchase (through Arbor clubs), there will be up to three matinee tickets and up to three evening tickets for each child. When you log into Arbor clubs, the option will appear as the following:

- Matinee 2
- Matinee 3
- Evening 1
- Evening 2
- Evening 3

To cover the hiring of the venue as well as their amazing technical team for staging and lighting, tickets this year will be **£8.00 each**. Tickets will go live on Arbor the week commencing **Monday 22nd June**. Purchased tickets will then be given to the children on **Friday 10th July** and any attendees will need to bring their tickets to the performances. **Unfortunately, we will not be able to allow entry without a ticket.**

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Refreshments

During the matinee performance there will not be an interval, however in the evening performance there will. Friends of Locks Heath have offered to run a bar and sell refreshments and some sweet snacks. This will be cash only on the night and will be open before the performance as well as during the interval. Nearer to the performance, we will give you more information surrounding this.

Year 6 leavers' celebrations

On the morning of Monday 20th July, we will be holding a Year 6 water fight. The Year 6 children are invited to bring in their own named water pistols for this. Please be aware any items brought into school for this are done so at the children's own risk and it will be their responsibility to take care of it.

Then on the afternoon of Monday 20th July, the Year 6 team are planning some further exciting activities to celebrate the children's time with us at Locks Heath Junior School. This will involve an inflatable obstacle course, opportunities where the children can relax with their friends, enjoy some music as well as an edible treat. For the edible treat, we have used the dietary information that we have from your child's medical records to ensure there is something suitable. Therefore, if there are any allergies, we have not been made aware of please do let your child's class teacher know. For this day, please can the children bring in their **PE kits** so that they have something they can change into after the water fight ready for the afternoon activities.
